 24.119 community pharmacists and 24.119 community pharmacies (pharmacy ownership is restricted to pharmacist and one pharmacist can own only one pharmacy)

5223 pharmacists working in other sectors

- First CDP (MIEP) in 1986 at Ankara University Faculty of Pharmacy (AUFP)
- Community Pharmacists asked AUFP and Ankara Chamber of Pharmacists for a post grad program
- The reason for this request was: curriculum thought at Faculties of Pharmacy did not meet the needs of the community pharmacist

- •First Aid, Social Pharmacy, Use of PCs in Community Pharmacy was included in the 26 subjects being covered
- 26 Teaching Staff Lectured
- •139 Community Pharmacists registered to attend
- •The feedback from this first CDP revealed the duration was long, subjects were too many and lengthy. (Clinical Pharmacy, Pharmaceutical Care, Patient Oriented Pharmacy and GPP had not emerged yet!)
- •Community Pharmacists wanted more practical updates on their already existing knowledge...

 2 years later (1988) at Ege Univ. Faculty of Pharmacy the MIEP organised was *Antibacterial and Antiviral Drugs*

The lecturers were selected not only from Ege Univ.
 but also from other faculties

1995 to 2002

162 MIEP's were organised by **Chamber of Pharmacies** with lecturers from:

Ankara University,

Istanbul University,

Hacettepe University,

Ege University,

Gazi University,

Marmara University and

Anadolu University

8500 pharmacists attended these MIEPs

In 1996 at the general assembly of Pharmacists Association 18 topics were chosen for MIEP's

- Antibiotics
- Analgesics
- Hypertension
- Diabetes
- Asthma
- Peptic ulcer
- Contraception
- Drugs used to treat children
- Substance abuse and dependence

- Childhood Respiratory infections
- Phytotherapy
- Pharmacy administration
- Stress and ways to manage it
- Family planning
- Maternal health
- Vaccines
- Drugs used to treat Musculoskeletal Diseases
- First Aid

In 2002 TEB formed TEB Academy

- CDPs are structured and conducted by the staff of the 13 Faculty of Pharmacies (Community Pharms?)
- •This centralised system provides quality control and has brought the individual local organisations into a more disciplined frame.
- •Faculties of Pharmacy and the Chambers; still together or on their own conduct their own CDPs for more local purposes.

200 MIEPs were organised since 2002, the establishment of TEB Academy
 9000 pharmacists received attendance certificates

RESULTS FROM THE FOLLOW UP STUDY

2002-2009

- 59.2% female, 40.8% male
- 86.1% found the MIEP's they attended very useful
- 70% of the pharmacists expressed a need for "distant learning" programs
- Years from graduation: ≥ 6yrs ≤35 years
 (formal education needs updating in 6 years)

The reason for attending a MIEP:

- 37.7 % new drugs and technologies
- 12.3 % phytotherapy
- 10.9 % analgesics treatment of pain
- 10.5 % pharmaceutical care / clinical pharmacy
- 7.4 % diabetes
- 7.0 % birth control/family planning
- 5.2 % hypertension
